LETTER FROM THE MONSIGNOR

And said to Mary his mother: Behold this Child is set for the fall, and for the resurrection of many in Israel, and for a sign which shall be contradicted; And thy own soul a sword shall pierce, that, out of many hearts, thoughts may be revealed.

- S. Luke 2:34 - 35

EVOTION to the Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary is so powerful and laudable that the Holy Church places it on the Octave Day of the Our Lady's Assumption into Heaven. While the devotion to Our Lady's Heart is quite ancient the feast, 22 August, is quite new, being instituted by Pope Pius XII in 1944; however, after the NewChurch took power it has moved this feast twice and in many places it is no longer celebrated at all.

The need to remove the devotional life of faithful Catholics has greatly hindered the faith that gave strength and succor to millions over the centuries, especially during persecution times of distress. The NewReligion of Vatican II has destroyed the belief in Our Lord's True Presence, Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity in the Most Blessed Sacrament: so if you do not honour Our Lord why honour His mother? This is all part of the evil one's plan for

humanity to fall far from the Faith. The Protest-ant revolt did less to harm the Faith than the NewReligion of Vatican II has, and at least Luther *et al* had the honesty to confirm they had separated from the Holy Church, unlike the false modernist religion that was *created* in the mid twentieth century.



Devotion to Our Ladv and her Most Pure Heart confirms the teaching of Our Lord, her Son: Blessed are the clean of heart: for they shall see God (S. Matthew 5:8), and her presence before the Throne of the Most Holy Trinity is our hope; if we could detach ourselves from this world, we too can see God Almighty. Preventing our sanctification is the evil one's plan, he seeks to deprive us from God, not only to make us suffer, but also to mock God, Whom he hates: He that committeth sin is of the devil: for the devil sinneth from the beginning (I S. John 3:8).

Our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ, teaches us that only those who have and keep a clean and pure heart will see God: ever since man lost the glory of his original innocence through the filth of his original sin, he has attempted to regain and restore himself to the grace and friendship of God. We must understand that Holy Purity is not just for our little children, it is not just for a select few chosen by God, it is a requirement for us all, you and me, so that we can make it to heaven. Even the married are called to remain pure, they must keep their marriages pure and undefiled, remaining faithful to their vows of Holy Matrimony, forsaking all others.

Because Our Lady remains pure and immaculate she was always able to see the face of God in her Divine Son, we are even told through pious private revelation that Our Lady always saw the angels about her Son and she certainly saw His glory to a greater degree than even the Disciples Our Lord's at Transfiguration. This ability to see the true countenance of Our Lord is proof of her immaculate holiness; if not for our sin, original and actual, we too could gaze upon the face of God! Her uniqueness was meant to be our normal state, but we, through our first parents, lost it, and therefore she is to be honoured and loved above all creatures for never losing her perfect state of grace.

As always, I am most grateful for your prayers and support. Be assured of my paternal benediction and prayers, especially at Holy Mass.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Monsignor:
I truly appreciate your clear explanation of Catholic teaching, but recently a family member said that you are not very "tolerant" and that if you were less dogmatic you might be able to reach more people. How can I answer them? In Christ the King, Anonymous

When Our Blessed Lord taught concerning those who persecuted the Baptist and other prophets and teachers He said He that hath ears to hear, let him hear (S. Matthew 11:15). Certainly I am neither a prophet or a great teacher, but Our Lord's admonition is clear: how one receives the teaching of Christ and His True Church is on them. S. Augustine teaches us in his commentaries on the psalms: Tolerantia quae dicitur ... non est nisi in malis. Which means: "tolerance pertains only to things that are bad". We tolerate things that are adverse, things we cannot avoid without incurring some greater adversity or evil. As one of my seminary professors used to say: you tolerate a cold, not a person. The very word "tolerate" comes from tollere, the Latin infinitive meaning to remove or take away. To tolerate something does not mean to "put up with it," rather, it means to remove it or take it away as soon as possible. I cannot, in conscience, water down the doctrine of God or His Holy Church, and still remain faithful to the promises of my Baptism, Ordfination and

Consecration. I am bound to them even under pain of death. I am simply an unworthy messenger, and the teaching does not belong to me, but to God. Let us pray that the hearts of those who rebel against Our Lord's sublime teaching soften and they come to Christ so they can save their soul!

8 December 2023 (Friday)

Feast of the Nativity of the Lord

SUNDAYS OF AUGUST: THE CATHOLIC HAND MISSAL

In order to properly assist the faithful following Holy Mass with their hand missals here are the Sunday Masses for August:

6 August 2023:

Transfiguration of the Lord:

Commemoration of the Tenth Sunday after Pentecost and S. Xystus II, Pope & Companions at the Collect, Secret and Postcommunion.

13 August 2023:

Eleventh Sunday after Pentecost:

Commemoration of the Ss. Hippolytus & Cassian, Martyrs and the Suffrage of the Saints at the Collect, Secret and Postcommunion.

20 August 2023:

Twelfth Sunday after Pentecost:

Commemoration of S. Bernard and the Octave of the Assumption of the BVM at the Collect, Secret and Postcommunion.

27 August 2023:

Thirteenth Sunday after Pentecost:

Commemoration of S. Foseph of Colassanctius at the Collect, Secret and Postcommunion.

To correctly participate at Holy Mass one *silently* unites his prayers with those of the Church through pious and attentive meditation of the prayers and reading of Holy Mass.

If you are unsure how to correctly set your hand missal arrive early for Holy Mass and ask the Monsignor to assist you. It is also important to become familiar with the Ordinary of the Mass, those parts that never change, i.e.: Kyrie, Gloria, Creed, Sanctus, Benedictus, and the Agnus Dei. And of course the Canon of the Mass, and the Propers of the Mass, those which vary according to the feasts of the i.e., Introit. Collect(s)(after the Gloria or Dominus Vobiscum), Epistle, Gradual, Alleluia, Tract or Sequence, Gospel, Secret, Communion Verse and Post Communion. On many feasts or days there are Commemorations (additional prayers) at the Collect. Secret and Postcommunion. The careful attention to these prayers and readings will help one enter into deeper spiritual relationship with the Holy Saints Liturgy, the and Mysteries of God.
