LETTER FROM THE MONSIGNOR

207 Christ, being come an Dhigh Priest of the good things to come, by a greater and more perfect tabernacle not made with hand, that is, not of this creation: Neither by the blood of goats, or of calves, but by his own Blood, entered once into the holies, having obtained eternal redemption. For if the blood of goats and of oxen, and the ashes of an heifer being sprinkled, sanctify such as are defiled, to the cleansing of the flesh: how much more shall the Blood of Christ, Who by the Holy Chost offered Himself unspotted unto God, cleanse our conscience from dead works, to serve the Living God?

- Hebrews 9:11 – 14

HE pouring out of the very life-blood of Our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, part of His act of immolation upon the Holy Cross, exemplifies the depth of God's love for His creature.

When I was a youth, many, many years ago, I was at a vocation retreat, and the Father in charge of our morning meditation gave a profound analogy that has never left me: imagine that the only way that you could save a slug was to become the loathsome creature, and then be put to death by those same creatures... the dramatic comparison, while extreme,

gives much to meditate upon and consider. The love of God is so profound and unending that He not only gave us a means of restoration and redemption, but He also *became* that means of restoration and redemption!

In his Tract 12 o of S. Fohn, that great and holy Doctor of the Church, S. Augustine, teaches us: The soldier did pierce His Side, thus to fling wide the entrance unto life, whence flow the Sacraments of the Church, those Sacraments without which there is no entrance unto the life that is life indeed. The Blood which was shed from that Side was shed for the remission of sins; that Water is the water that mantleth the laver of Baptism which is our cup of salvation. Therein are we washed, and thereof do we drink...



So also was it that the first woman was made from the side of her husband while he slept, and she was called Eve, which is, being interpreted, Life, because she was the mother of the living. This name set forth a great good, before it became associated with the bitter fruit of a great evil. And here [in Christ] we have the Second Adam bowing His head, and the deep sleep of death falling upon Him upon the Cross, and He sleepeth,

that from there a spouse [the Church] might be formed for Him, even from that which He shed from His side as He slept. O what a death was His, which quickeneth the dead! What is cleaner than His Blood? What more health-giving than His wounding?

This sublime connection of Father Adam and Christ Jesus, the New Adam, exemplifies the perfect order created and put forth by God for everything, and only a sinful and disordered mind fails to understand the saint's point.

I hope and pray that all who read this little newsletter will truly meditate upon and give honour and gratitude to the Blood of Christ, shed for love of you and I. Please share this newsletter to bring Faith and Hope to those who may be struggling in this world of confusion and disorder: the solution is there for all who seek it, calling to mind the words of the Apostle; Blessed be the God and Father of Our Lord Fesus Christ, the Father of mercies, and the God of all comfort. Who comforteth us in all our tribulation; that we also may be able to comfort them who are in all distress, by the exhortation wherewith we also are exhorted by God. For as the sufferings of Christ abound in us: so also by Christ doth our comfort abound (II Corinthians 1:3-5).

As always, be assured of my paternal benediction and prayers, especially at Holy Mass.

In order to assist the faithful following Holy Mass with

their hand missals here are the Sunday Masses for July:

7 July 2024:

Seventh Sunday after Pentecost: Commemoration of Ss. Cyril & Methodius, Bishops and Confessors at the Collect, Secret and Postcommunion.

14 July 2024: Eighth Sunday after Pentecost:

Commemoration of S. Bonaventure, Bishop, Confessor and Doctor of the Church at the Collect, Secret and Postcommunion.

21 July 2024:

Ninth Sunday after Pentecost:

Commemoration of S. Praxedes, Virgin and the Suffrage of the Saints at the Collect, Secret and Postcommunion.

28 July 2024:

Tenth Sunday after Pentecost: Commemoration of S. Nazarius & Companions and the Suffrage of the Saints at the Collect, Secret and Postcommunion.

Mass one *silently* unites his prayers with those of the Church through pious and attentive meditation of the prayers and reading of Holy Mass.

If you are unsure how to correctly set your hand missal arrive early for Holy Mass and ask the Monsignor to assist you. It is also important to become familiar with the Ordinary of the Mass, those parts that never change, i.e.: Kyrie, Gloria, Creed, Sanctus, Benedictus, and the Agnus Dei. And of course the Canon of the Mass, and the Propers of the Mass, those which vary according to the feasts of the day, i.e., Introit, Collect(s)(after the Gloria or Dominus Vobiscum), Epistle, Gradual, Alleluia, Tract or Sequence, Gospel, Secret, Communion Verse and Communion. On many feasts or days there are Commemorations (additional prayers) at the Collect, Secret and Postcommunion. The careful attention to these prayers

3 and readings will help one enter into a deeper spiritual relationship with the Holy Liturgy, the Saints and Mysteries of God.


