LETTER FROM THE MONSIGNOR

B^{UC} God forbid that 1 should glory, save in the Cross of our Lord Jesus Christ : by whom the world is crucified to me, and 1 to the world. – Galatians 6:14

UR most blessed Patron, S. Francis of Assisi, the Seraphic Father, has been much aligned by the modernist heretics; he was not a pacifist hippy who wondered about with flowers in his hair, petting all the animals and using genderneutral pronouns. He was manly saint who boldly condemned the lax errors of his time, most especially spiritual heresy, laxity, Mohamedism and sodomite clergy. His love of creatures was predicated upon his love of the *Creator*, Whom he found in all of creation.

The Church during the lifetime of our Patron Saint was, like today, was filled with men who had a lust for power and material gain, and the highest of even authorities in her were wont of such sin and immorality rather than true holiness and virtue. So many of her clergy lacked even a general care for souls and the comfort of the afflicted and those in need; building up their own little empires and kingdoms was more to their liking.

When Father Matthew Howard and I established our little Oratory under the patronage of the Seraphic Father S. Francis in 1997 it was to honour him for his work of proper and well-ordered restoration as well as the missionary work that was done in his name here in Southern California. Like so many of us today who remain faithful to the true and authentic teachings of the Holy Church, we take all too literal the call to restore all things in Christ (cf. Ephesians 1:10): we seek a worldly spiritual solution to а problem. First, let us that remember we. the faithful, do not restore the Church - the Church restores us! It is not the Church that needs repair, but rather, many of her members who have become corrupt and comfortable in their sin.



If we, like dearest Holy Francis, would worry less about the world and more about heaven we could accomplish so much more. When equity and social justice are applied without God's principles than we build that house upon sand (cf. S. Mathew 7:26 - 27), as the Psalmist teaches us, Unless the Lord build the house, they labour in vain that build it. Unless the Lord keep the city, he watcheth in vain that keepeth it (Psalm 126:1). How beautiful is the command of Our Lord and King to focus on what is true important: and Seek уe therefore first the Kingdom of God, and His justice, and all these things shall be added unto you. Be not therefore solicitous for tomorrow; for the morrow will be solicitous for itself. Sufficient for the day is the evil thereof (S. Matthew 6:33 - 34).

Lastly, we are settling in quite nicely into our little rental home, praise God for His great generosity; please continue to help us with your prayers and material support.

As always, I am most grateful for your prayers and support. Be assured of my paternal benediction and prayers, especially at Holy Mass.

> **SUNDAYS OF OCTOBER**: THE CATHOLIC HAND MISSAL

In order to assist the faithful following Holy Mass with their hand missals here are the Sunday Masses for September:

1 October 2023: Eighteenth Sunday after Pentecost:

Commemoration of S the *Remigius*, *Bishop* and the *Suffrage* of the Saints at the Collect, Secret and Postcommunion.

8 October 2023 : Nineteenth Sunday after Pentecost:

Commemoration of S. Bridget of Sweeden, Widow at the Collect, Secret and Postcommunion.

15 October 2023: Twentieth Sunday

after Pentecost:

Commemoration of S. Teresa of Avila, Virgin at the Collect, Secret and Postcommunion.

22 October 2023:

Twenty-First Sunday after Pentecost:

Commemoration of the Suffrage of the Saints and Against the Pagans at the Collect, Secret and Postcommunion.

29 October 2023: Feast of CHIRST THE KING:

Commemoration of the Twenty-Second Sunday after Pentecost at Collect. Secret the and Postcommunion.

O correctly participate at Holy Mass one *silently* unites his prayers with those of the Church through pious and attentive meditation of the prayers and reading of Holy Mass.

If you are unsure how to correctly set your hand missal arrive early for Holy Mass and ask the Monsignor to assist you. It is also important to become familiar with the Ordinary of the Mass, those parts that never change, i.e.: Kyrie, Gloria, Creed, Sanctus, Benedictus, and the Agnus Dei. And of course the Canon of the Mass, and the Propers of the Mass, those which vary according to the feasts of the day, i.e., Introit, Collect(s)(after the Gloria or Dominus Vobiscum), Epistle, Gradual, Alleluia, Tract or Sequence, Gospel, Secret, Communion Verse and Post Communion. On many feasts or days there are Commemorations (additional prayers) at the Collect, Secret and Postcommunion. The careful attention to these prayers and readings will help one enter into a deeper spiritual relationship with the Holy Liturgy, the Saints and Mysteries of God.
